

BUILD THE **Ferrari 330 P4**

THE MOST BEAUTIFUL RACING CAR OF ALL TIME



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Unanimously regarded as one of the most beautiful prototypes in history, the Ferrari 330 P3/4 perfectly encapsulates a romantic era when motor racing was still almost a traditional craft that gave absolute priority to the construction of powerful engines and lightweight chassis. The 330 P4, a fascinating open-top two-seater with an extraordinary 4-liter 60° V12 engine developed by engineer Franco Rocchi, with three valves per cylinder and mechanical injection, was Ferrari's answer to the Ford GT40's victory in the 1966 24 Hours of Le Mans. Enzo Ferrari then asked his engineers to improve on the 330 P3 of the previous year, and they created a car equipped with a new 450 hp engine, longitudinally mounted at the rear in a tubular steel chassis reinforced with aluminum panels and complete with independent front and rear suspension. Able to reach a top speed of 320 km/h on the Hunaudières straight at Le Mans, the 330 P4 made its international debut at the 1967 Daytona 24 Hours, where Ferrari beat Ford on home turf, marking the triumph with the symbolic procession of its three cars on the final straight. The winner was number 23, driven by Chris Amon and Lorenzo Bandini, a P3/4 spider built in 1966, but benefiting from the engine and upgrades introduced on the new model P4s.



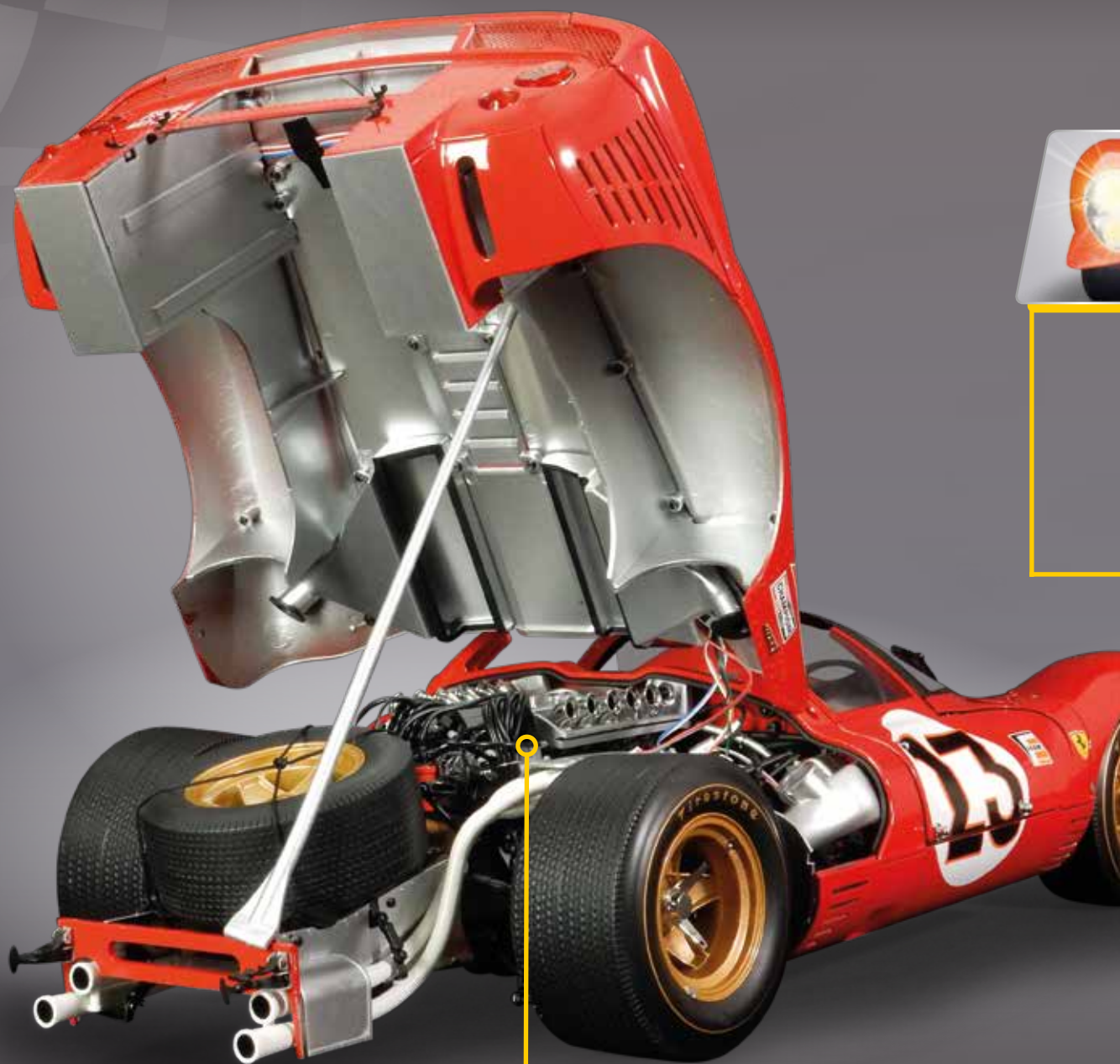
CONSTRUCT A LEGEND

This extraordinary model won not only the Daytona race, but also the 1,000 km of Monza, giving Ferrari another world championship title, before its disappearance following the change in regulations introduced by the International Federation in 1968, which limited the engine capacity of prototypes entered in endurance racing to three liters.

Owning an authentic Ferrari 330 P4 is now almost impossible. Of only three built, two were modified in 1968 to comply with the new regulations, and the third, the only one in its original condition, belongs to a private collector. But now you have the chance to own a Ferrari 330 P4 in your own home, a reproduction of the winner of the 1967 Daytona 24 Hours, an extraordinary 1:8 scale model, the largest in the exciting world of collecting, made of metal, and featuring every detail of the interior, chassis, and engine reproduced with absolute fidelity. It is an extraordinary model that lives up to the deserved reputation of the car itself, one of the most beautiful competition vehicles ever created by the legendary manufacturer of the "Prancing Horse."

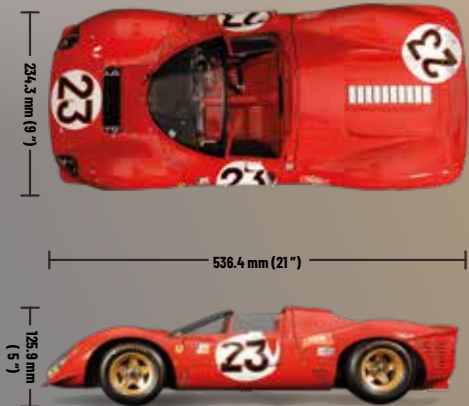
